The Ministry of Infrastructure, the Ministry of Health, and Indigenous Services Canada, in collaboration with the Weeneebayko Area Health Authority (WAHA), will deliver a new ambulatory care centre ("the Project") on Moose Factory Island. The figure shows the Project location. The Project will include a new ambulatory care centre, parking lot, helipad and associated dock on Moose River. IO completed a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Project and met the requirements of the Government Property Category B Class EA.
